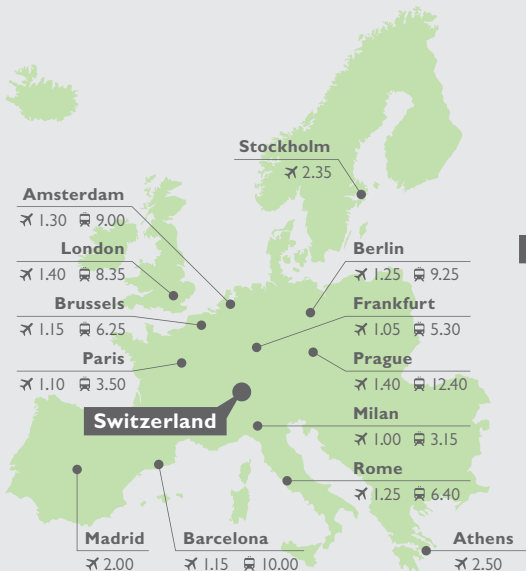
Intercontinental distances

Flight times to Geneva (GVA) or Zurich (ZRH) airport



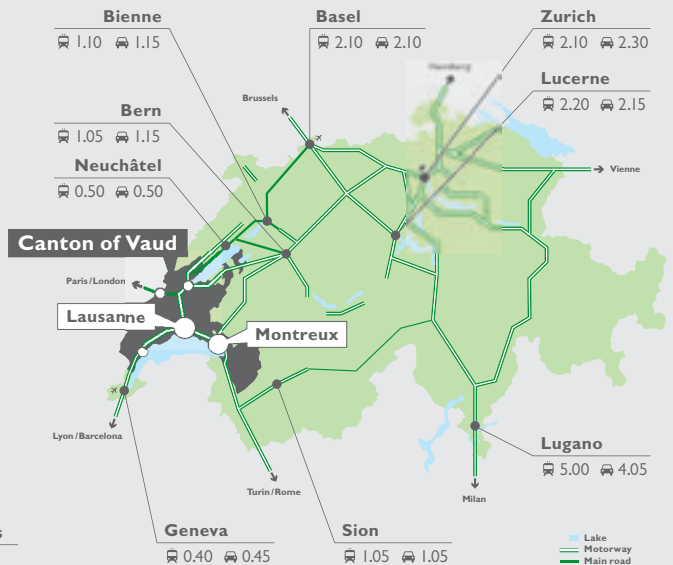
Distances within Europe

The building is currently being renovated and modernised in order to boost the largest exhibition centre in the Canton of Vaud.

The future of international conferences

The Swiss Tech Convention Center of the Federal Institute of Technology in Lausanne (EPFL) will open its doors in late 2013. The modular system is the main feature of this centre. It is intended for conferences, seminars and business conventions and equipped with ultramodern technology. Its auditorium with 3,000 seats can be transformed into a banquet hall in a few minutes by retracting the steps simply by pressing a button. As to the basement of the centre, it can take the shape of a giant hall or can be separated into 15 independent rooms.

The Canton of Vaud has 3 conference and exhibition centres that are large enough for large-scale events. Their infrastructure is adapted to the organisation of international conferences with several thousand participants.



2m2c Montreux Music & Convention Centre

An exceptional venue

On the shores of Lake Geneva, this centre of 18,000 square metres is located next to palaces and the Montreux Casino. The “2m2c”, as its brand name, is totally modular and multifunctional. It is divided into two main buildings: the Miles Davis is used primarily for events with up to 1,200 people, while the Auditorium Stravinski, which is renowned for its acoustics, can receive 3,500 persons, such as during the Montreux Jazz Festival, which sees a plethora of artists of world renown each year.

Exploited since 1684, the Bex Salt Mines are still active today. There is a seminar room, as well as a restaurant in the “bowels” of the earth.

Glacier 3000 (Les Diablerets)

Located at an altitude of 3,000 metres, Glacier 3000 has been designed for various events, such as evening meetings, product launches, press conferences or incentives.

Rolex Learning Center (Lausanne)

Romainmôtier

The abbey church of Romainmôtier nestles in the verdant countryside and is one of the oldest Romanesque churches of Switzerland. Church services, concerts and banquets are held in Maison du Prieur.

GoldenPass – Montreux-Lucerne

The GoldenPass train line connects Montreux to Lucerne via Château-d'Oex, Gstaad and Interlaken. Travel in a panoramic train across the Alps.

Gruyères

At the foot of the Pre-Alps, the charming medieval village of Gruyères attracts visitors with its picturesque architecture. The village lent its name to the entire region and to its tasty cheese.

Zermatt

Zermatt nestles at the foot of the Matterhorn, the world's most photographed mountain. This resort is the very symbol of Switzerland with its high, sublime and authentic Alps.

MUSIC

Montreux Jazz Festival *JULY*

Every year, Montreux transforms into the capital of jazz. Tens of thousands of spectators attend the concerts performed in the sumptuous Auditorium Stravinsky and the Miles Davis Hall. In addition, the convivial Festival Off, which is free of charge, attracts a large audience in the streets and on the lakeside quays in this town on the Swiss Riviera.

Avenches Opera Festival *JULY*

A unique setting in the Roman arenas of Avenches, internationally reputed artists, top-quality stage direction and stunning sets attract tens of thousands of spectators on the occasion of the Opera Festival. Rigoletto, Don Juan or La Bohème are just some of the classical works that were presented in the past few years.

Paléo Festival Nyon *JULY*

Every summer, more than 225,000 music lovers attend the open-air festival in Nyon, one of the largest in Europe. Rock, folk, French chanson, reggae, world music, and street theatre are performed on six different stages, totalling nearly 120 concerts over six days.

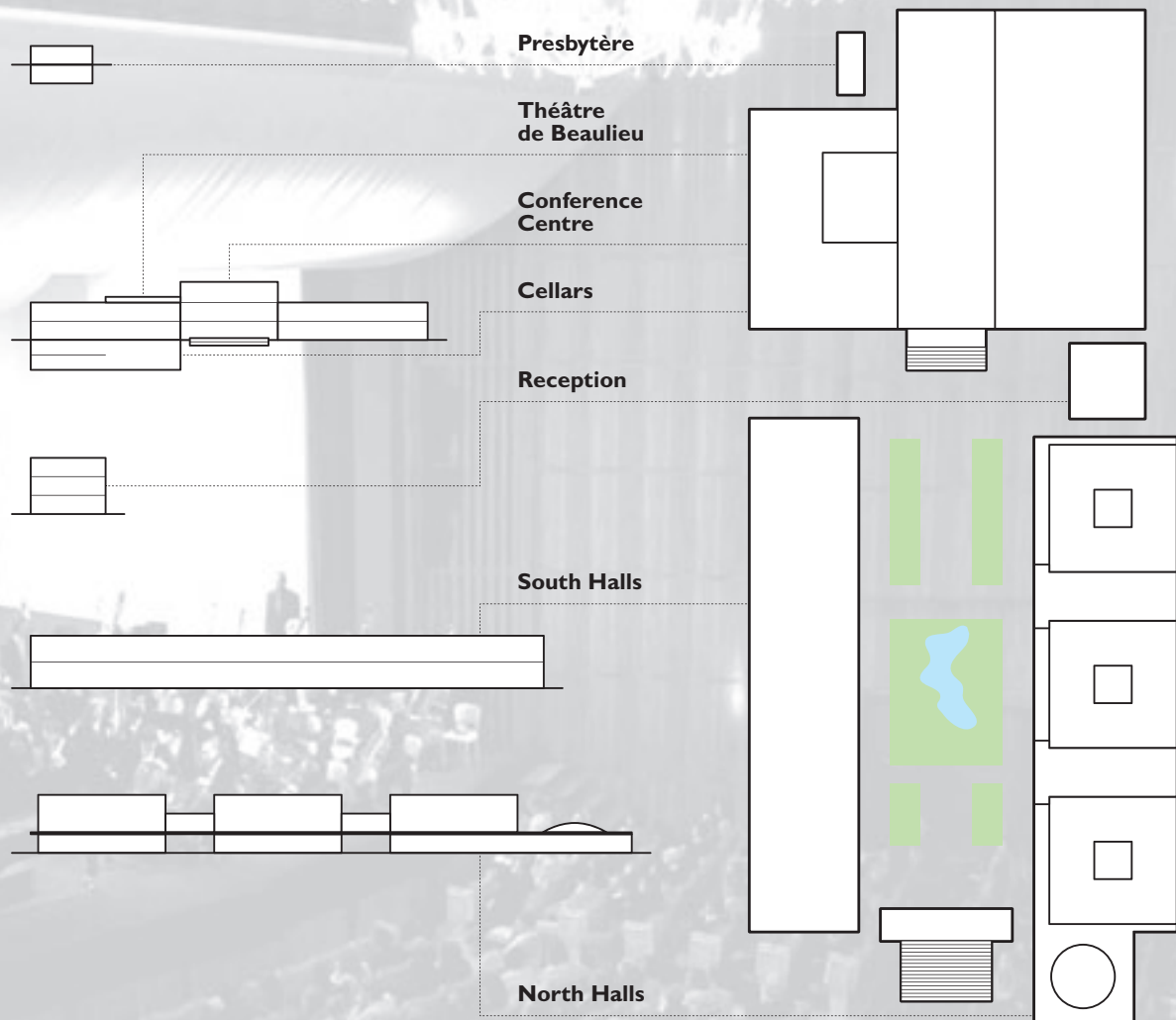

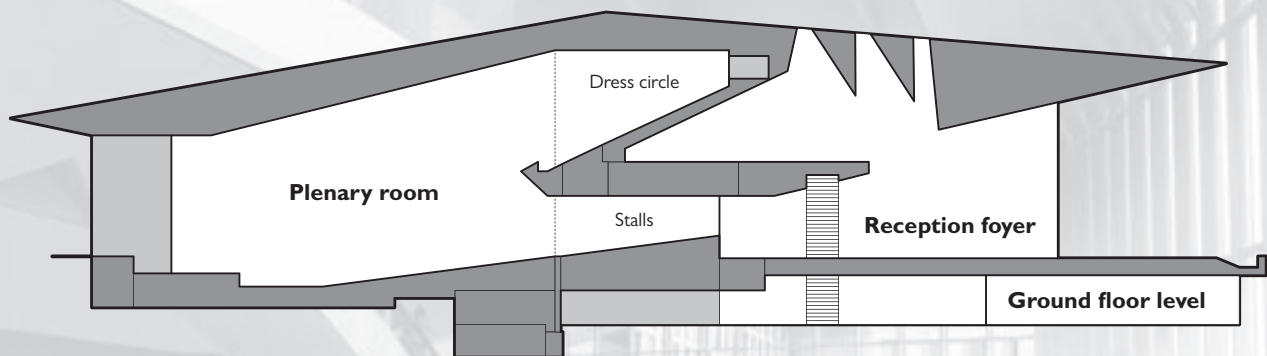

Opening in late 2013 The Swiss Tech Convention Center is located on the EPFL campus. It is the world's first totally automated conference centre. Its infrastructure with ultramodern facilities is flexible and can be transformed into auditoriums with computerised controls. The amphitheatre can be converted into a banquet hall within minutes.

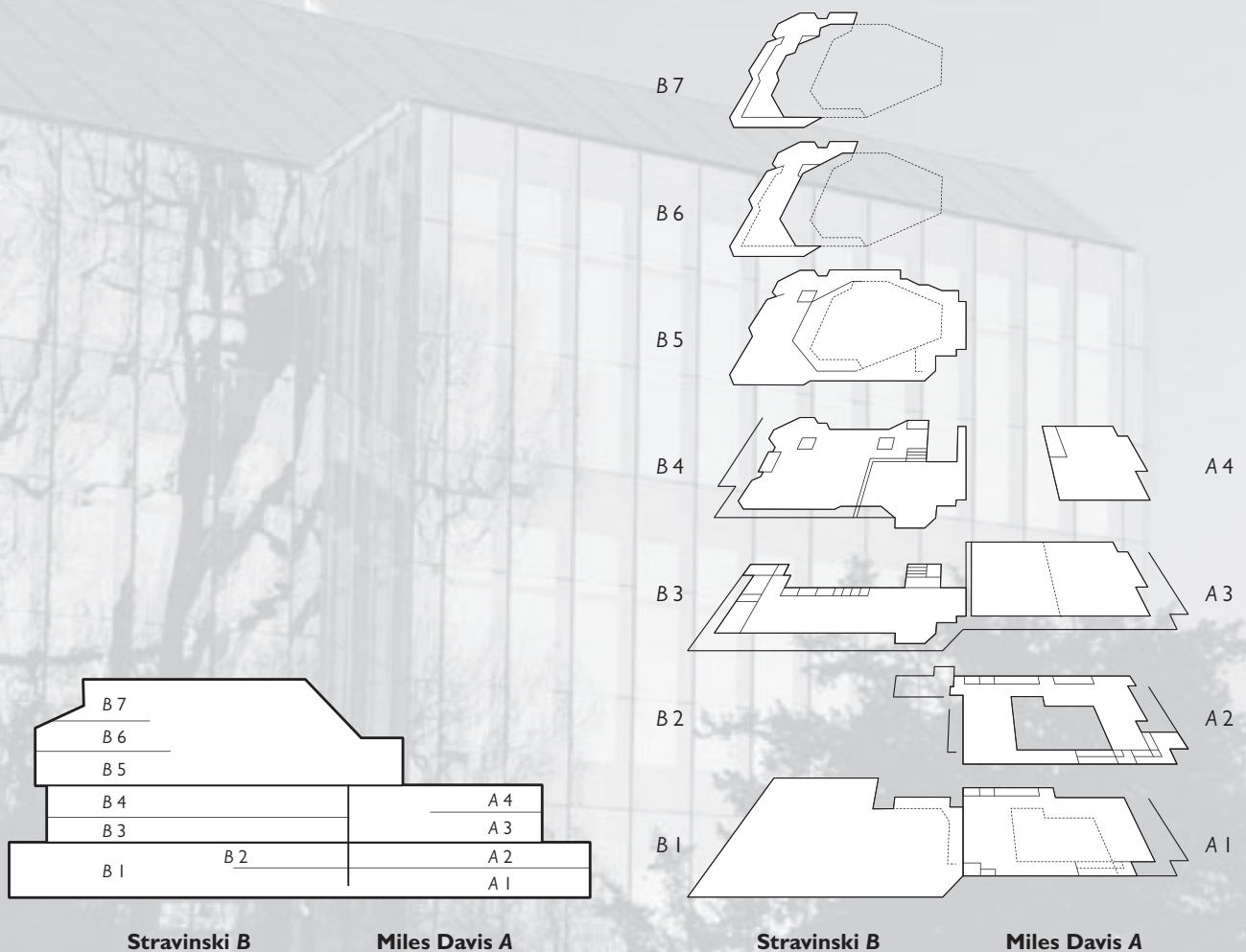
