Next to the TOM Café, the Gallery is an exhibition zone that can be hired privately in the evenings. In the warm season, the Gallery opens into a terrace with a panoramic view of the lake and the Alps. An entrance provides direct access to the Gallery from the outside, without entering The Museum; as well as the Terrace.

A light and bright place ideal for cocktails, meals or gala evenings.

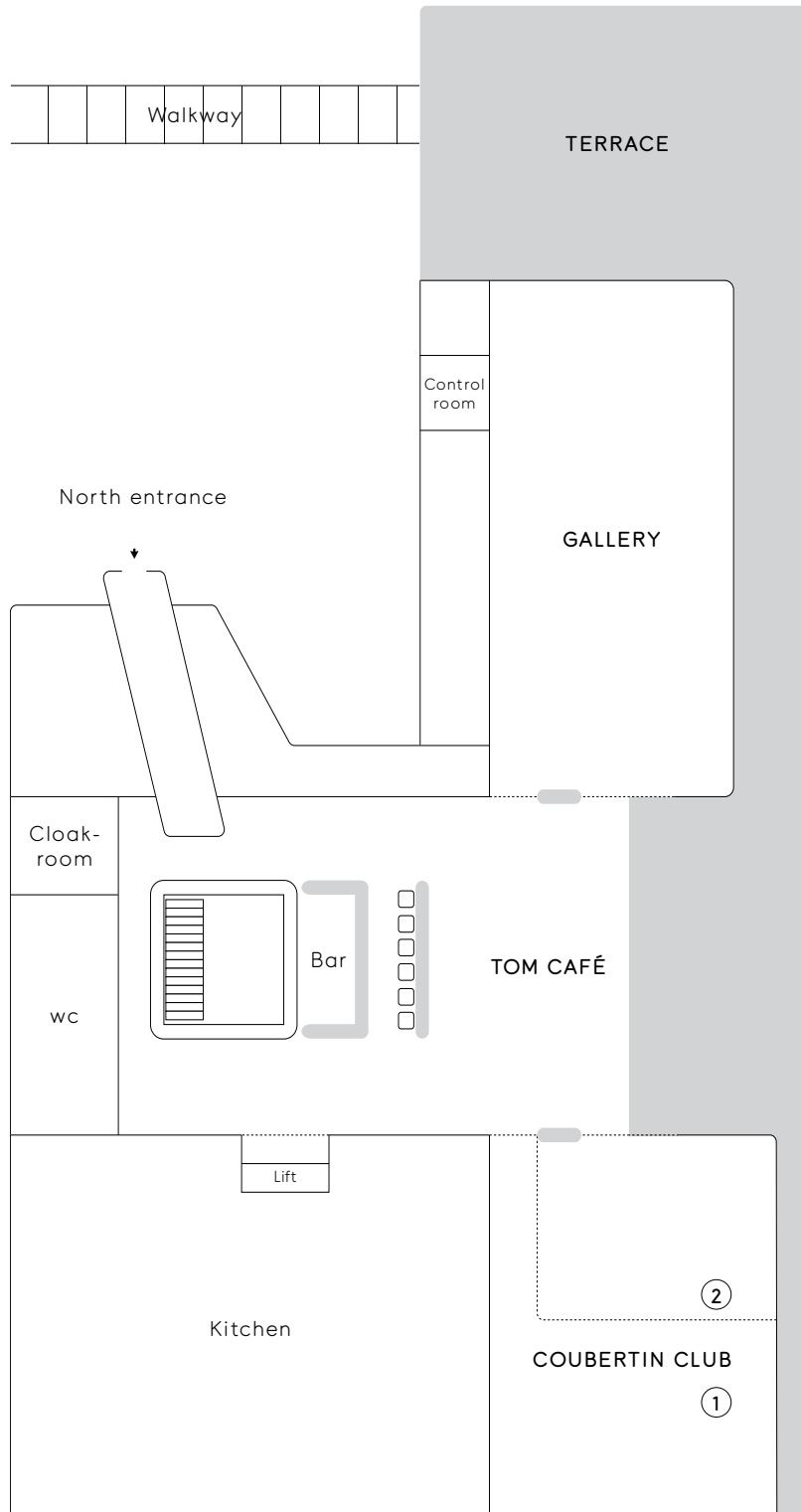

The Club, with its modern and elegant design, can be divided into two sections. Situated next to the TOM Café, it benefits from an exceptional view and has access to the terrace.

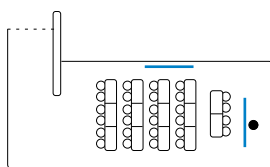
OLYMPIE ROOM

The ideal place to host meetings and seminars.

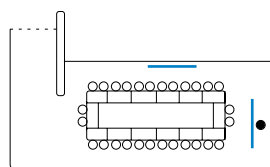

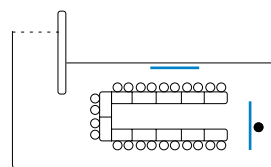

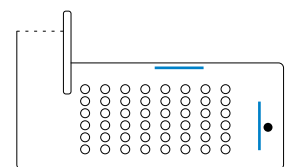
"School" configuration

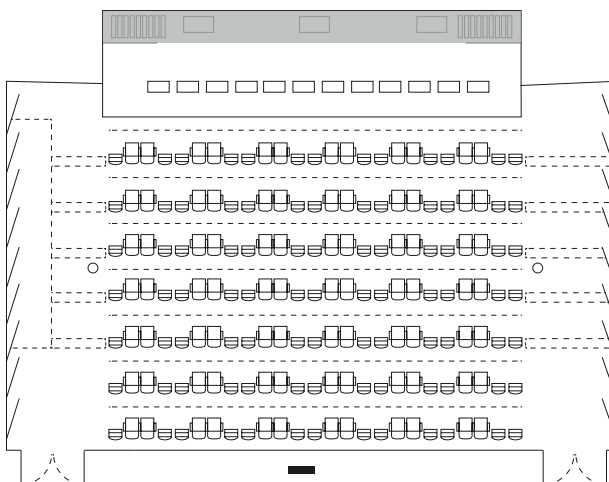
AUDITORIUM
