


Ticino is well connected by all means of transport. A dense network of bus and train routes takes visitors to the most remote corners of Ticino. Different legendary scenic routes, for example the Bernina Express, the Wilhelm Tell Express, or the Palm Express, provide the opportunity to discover Ticino in a pleasant and relaxing way. For special occasions, limousines, helicopters, horse carriages, tandems, paraglide, etc. can be organized for an unforgettable and exclusive adventure.

The airport of Lugano is located in Agno, which is only 4 km/2.5 mi away from the city center, and offers regular flights to Geneva and Zürich. Connecting shuttle buses will drop visitors off directly at their hotel in the city. Additionally, within 1 hour reach, there is the International airport of Milano Malpensa that is connected to Ticino by shuttle buses and train connections.




Rock Climbing in Ticino.

Ticino is a land of culture, of art and artists. The region is scattered with monuments and artworks of a rare beauty. All around, history, architecture and art intertwine, blending harmoniously into the landscape. In the valleys, you will be enchanted by the delightful little Romanesque churches; in the towns and cities, by the geometric symmetries of contemporary architecture. Furthermore, Ticino hosts throughout the year various types of events: music and film festivals, concerts, sporting events and shows enliven the cultural life of Ticino and add an extra dimension to visitors' stay.

A Medieval event in the castles.

Bellinzona

The three superbly restored castles of Bellinzona, listed by UNESCO as part of the World Heritage sites, are the perfect location for hosting special events in medieval style. Guests will be welcomed by people dressed as worriers in armours, trumpeters and craftsmen. In the afternoon, split in groups, guests will measure themselves in archery, tug-of-war and jousting tournaments, or take part to the re-enactment of William Tell's legend. The evening can continue with a dinner at Castelgrande and a menu with medieval dishes.





Ascona

The art of preparing and enjoying tea, that tea master Sen Rikyu perfected in Japan 450 years ago, has lost none of its fascination even today. The Teahouse Loreley on the Lago Maggiore is passionate about the tea ceremony it cultivates. Guests not only enjoy their favorite tea in a harmonious environment, but can also visit the tea museum and tea laboratory and even stock up on some of the world's finest teas in the tea shop.



Corporate Orchestra.

Ticino

From a starting point of non-existent musical skills emerges a team capable of producing excellent results. Integration between the group members is made easier and a huge boost of energy and emotion is generated. The challenge is a great surprise to the participants, although initially it appears to be impossible. They become a great orchestra in a few hours. Despite what one may think, the atmosphere is welcoming: AlpTransit is a cutting edge project and in Pollegio it holds an ultra-modern information centre on the premises. Built with the stones dug from the tunnel, the structure has fully equipped meeting rooms.

Robiei

Water from snow and glaciers is channelled to the Robiei and Bavona hydro plants, generating enough electricity for a city. Robiei, in an idyllic setting at 2000 metres, not only is the ideal starting point for hikers but also offers the unique opportunity to penetrate the bowels of the dam to tour it from within. This interesting educational tour, lasting about twenty minutes, reveals the secrets of dams in an easy way along the tunnels.



Discover the secrets of milk with LATI.

S. Antonino

Learn all about dairy production, including hard and soft cheeses and delicious yoghurts to suit all tastes. LATI SA uses milk from local Ticino-based producers, acting as a reference point for dairies in the local Alps. As well as giving a brief account of the company history, a visit to the museum will introduce you to the secrets behind the production of prized products. You will also have chance to try some of the specialities made at the company headquarters.











Charutos do Br...issago.

Brissago

The Centro Dannemann in Brissago is a fascinating event location housed in a traditional Brazilian cigar factory on Lake Maggiore. Enter fully into the world of tobacco by organising a workshop where you can roll your own cigar and enjoy it in good company on the lake shore. Learn how to make your own customised caipirinha or alternatively organise a sensory journey of discovery of a rich variety of aromas.





Visit a fire service.

Lugano

Founded in 1853, Lugano's fire service has more than one hundred years of history behind it. The firefighters work shifts, enabling the service to guarantee that two first-response engines can be sent out within two minutes of the alarm being raised, 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. The fire service will illustrate the important work it does during your free visit. A firefighter will take you on a tour of the station, showing you the equipment used to ensure the safety of the local population and offering practical advice to be applied in your place of work.

Comano/Lugano-Besso

The Radiotelevisione della Svizzera Italiana (RSI) is a public service of the Italian-speaking part of Switzerland, entrusted with producing and broadcasting radio and television programmes throughout the country. Your visit will involve an exciting tour of studios, production and editing rooms, teaching you all about RSI and those who work there. Lugano

The Università della Svizzera Italiana (USI) is the only Italian-speaking university outside of Italy. Founded in 1996, it has four faculties today: Economics, Communication Sciences, IT and Architecture, serving a student population of around 2800 from 100 different countries. It employs around 700 lecturers and assistants. During your free visit you will learn about the organisation, the facilities of the USI campus and its original and innovative courses.



Good to know.

Currency.

The Swiss franc is the monetary unit, usually indicated as CHF. Often is possible to pay in Euro, but normally the change will be returned in Swiss franc.

Exchange.

You can change money at any Swiss bank, airports, main hotels and train stations (Western Union) and at the Swiss Post. The current exchange rates can be found on: www.bancastato.ch

Language.

Switzerland has four official languages: German, French, Italian and Rhaeto-Rumantsch. In Ticino the official language is Italian but it's easy to find assistance in other foreign languages.

VAT.

In Switzerland the VAT applied on the purchase of goods and services is of 8%. You may ask at the shops for your Global Refund Cheque and reclaim the VAT. For more information regarding terms and conditions refer to Swiss Federal Tax Administration.

Phone area code.

The international area code for Switzerland is +41.

Opening times.

Shops are usually open Mondays to Fridays from 8/8.30 a.m. to 6.30 p.m.. Some shops extend their opening hours on Thursdays to 9 p.m. On Saturdays shops open from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. They are closed Sundays and on public holidays.

Voltage.

The Swiss voltage is 230 Volt and the frequency 50 Hertz (for the domestic electrical appliance up to 2200 Watt). Kitchens, washing machines and etc use 400 or 3x400 Volt. The wall socket is of J type.
