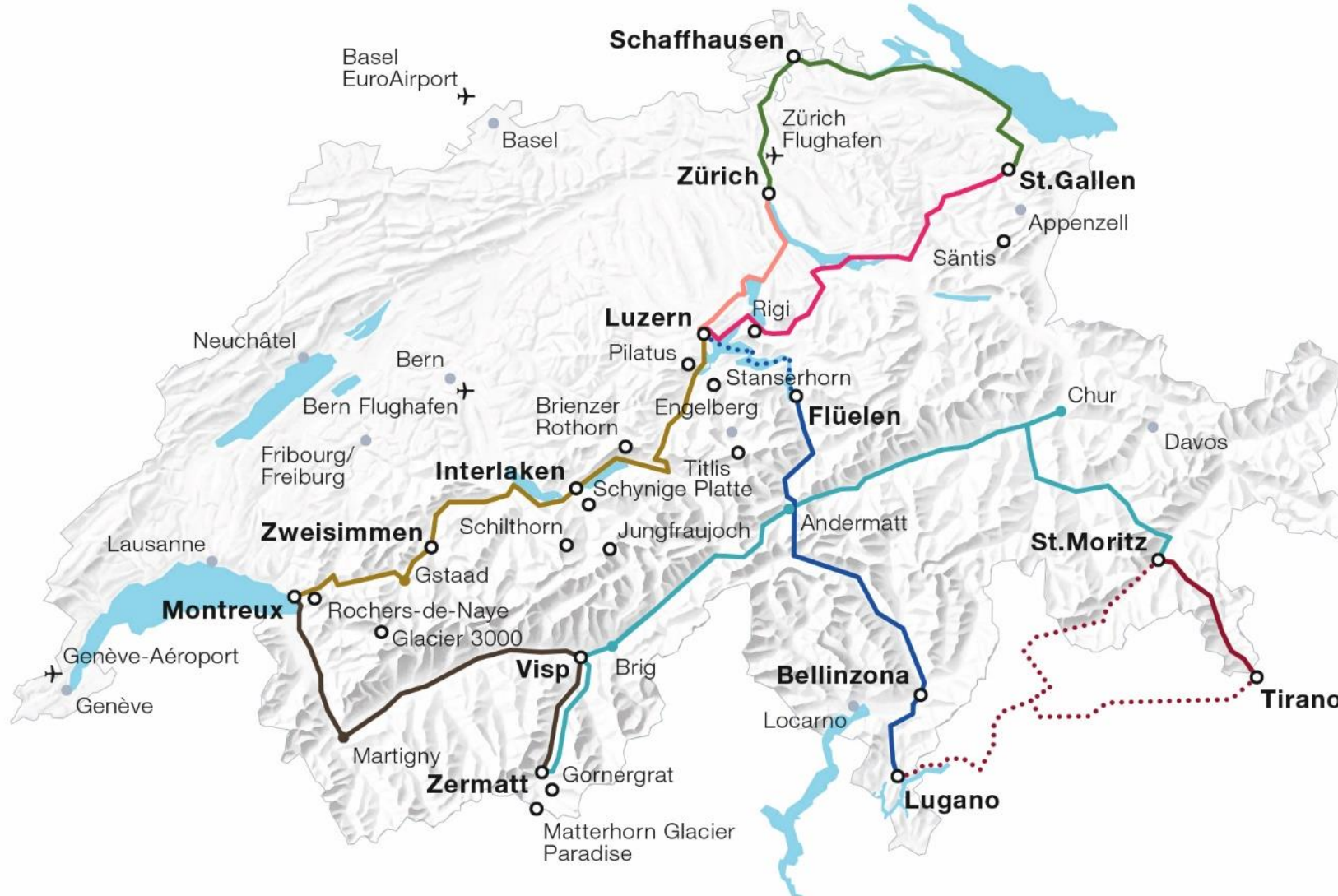

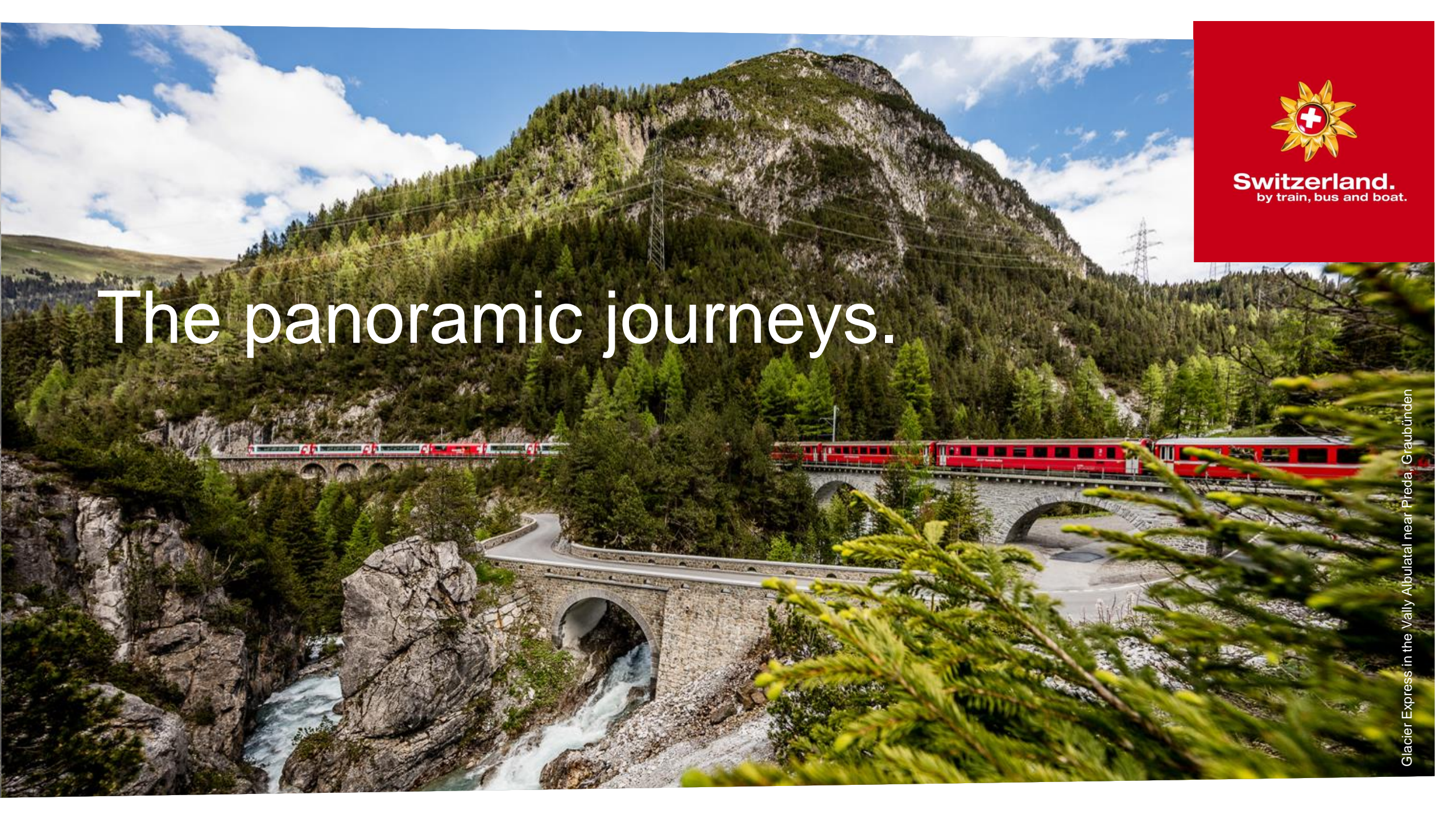

# Gotthard Panorama Express.

## From Lucerne to Bellinzona / Lugano



- **Route:** Lucerne–Lake Lucerne–Flüelen–Gotthard–Bellinzona–Lugano\*
- **Duration:** around 5h
- **Distance Luzern–Lugano:** 182 km

\* Runs from/to Lugano only Mo-Fr from July to October

Bringing northern and southern Europe and Switzerland closer together:

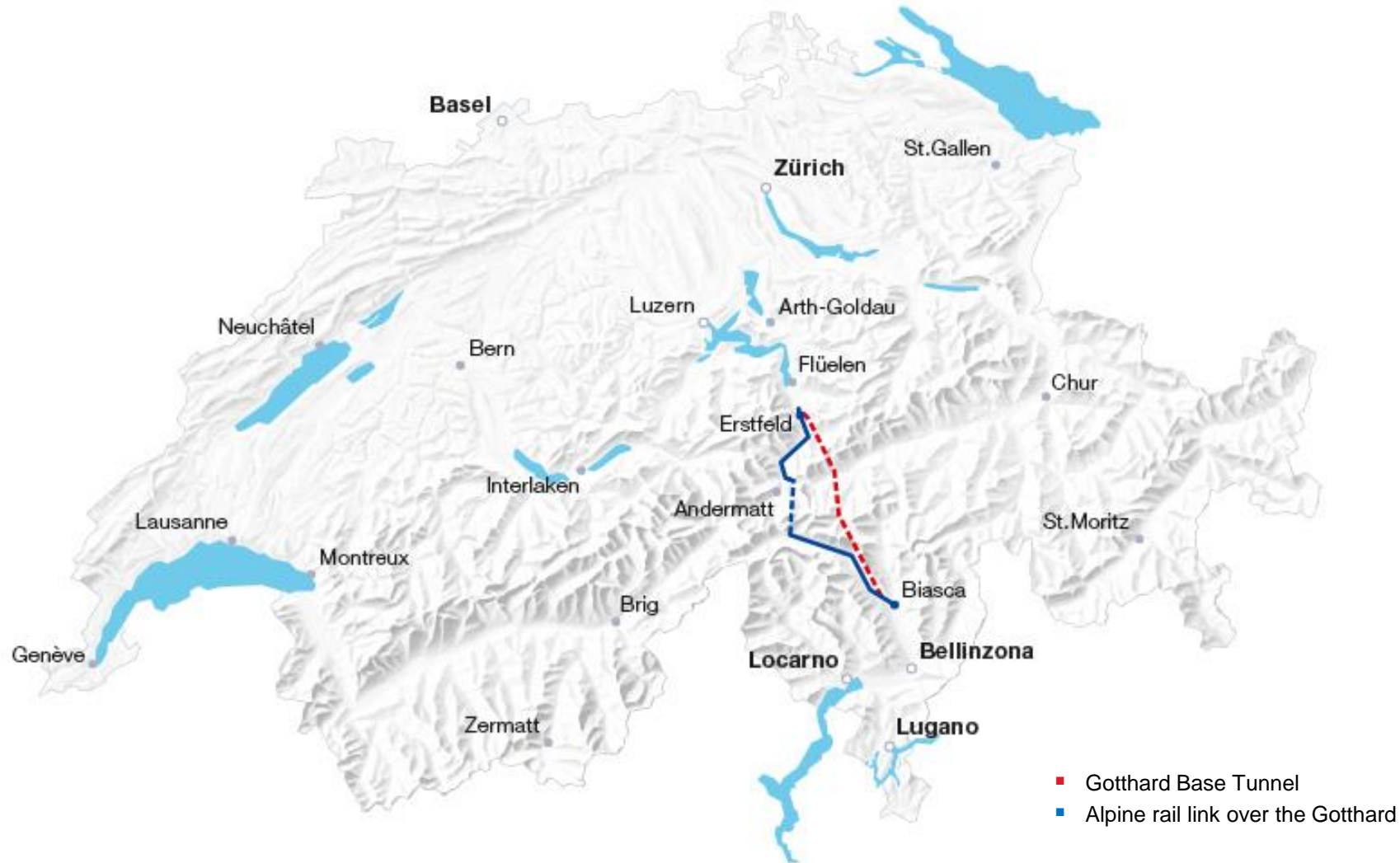
- Travel time through the tunnel – 20 minutes

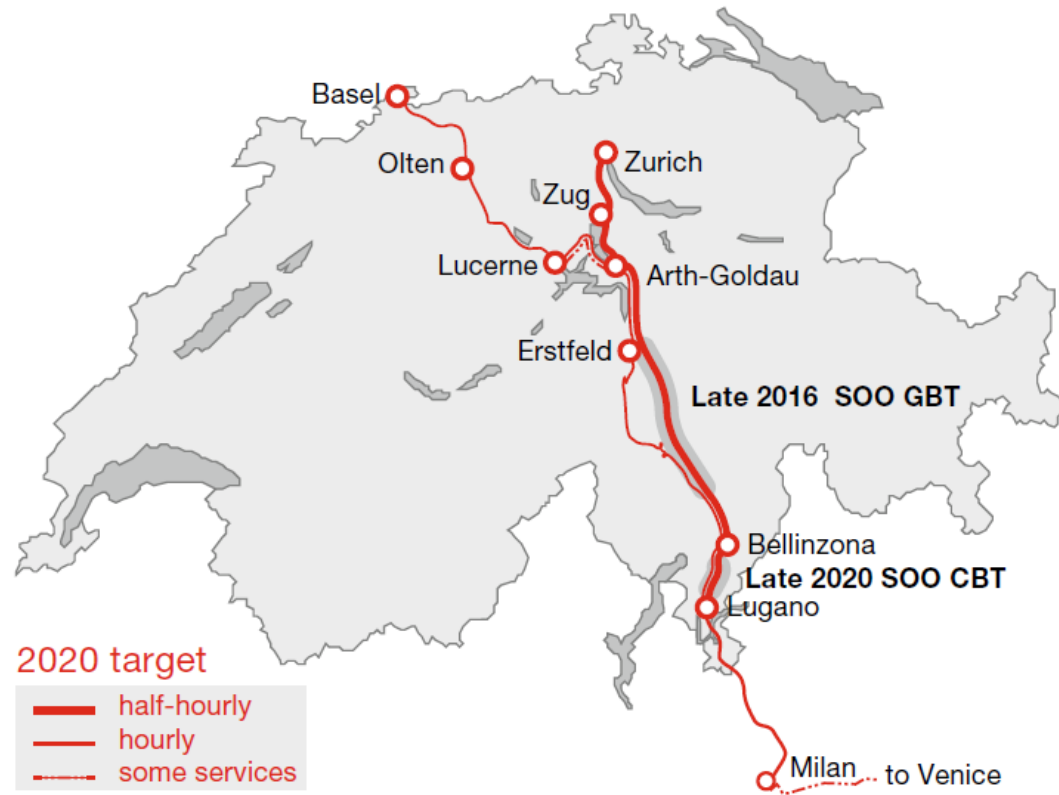

With the integration of the Gotthard Base Tunnel in 2016 as well as the Ceneri Base Tunnel at the end of 2019, travel times will be reduced as follows:

Free transfer from Swiss border / airport to the vacation destination and back.

Swiss Half Fare Card.



For one month, 50% discount off regular public transport fares for CHF 120. Also combinable with Swiss Travel Pass Flex and Swiss Transfer Ticket.

Swiss Family Card.



Children under 16 years of age travel free of charge with the Swiss Travel Card.

Pick-up	09.00 hrs latest
Delivery	18.00 hrs latest
Service points	400 service points throughout Switzerland. Subject to change
Group size	Minimum 10 persons, maximum 50 persons. Larger groups on request
Transport price	CHF 200 per transport – net without commission
Precondition	Valid ticket for each person for the entire transport distance
Booking change / cancellation	Up to 09.00 hrs (CET/CEST) on the day before start of transport, free of charge / later 50% of cost
Booking deadline	5 days before transportation at the latest

- Up to 110 seats
- On board kitchen
- Today in use only as charter train on the Swiss Federal Railway system
